STEPHEN MORSE, PhD, a well received local genealogist and lecturer, will demonstrate his one-step web pages that zeros in on your family's 1940 census profile. The 1940 census will not have a name index at the time of release. Census data is organized by the 1940 Enumeration Districts (EDs). Knowing the ED numbers for your family is essential to quickly finding your people in the census.

The EDs are composed of the unique numbers for each state. The first number specifies a region – usually a county. The second part of the number is a district within the county. If the address is not known, Stephen will share his tips to facilitate a quicker search than looking at all the names in the district.

The National Archives will release the census on line on April 2nd, 2012. There is no need to go to a library or archive to access this valuable genealogical information. Tap into the internet and retrieve your recent family history.
